The Lonsdale Centre is also the Trust's headquarters and main postal address for enquiries, correspondence and accounts.

The Trust operates year round, weekdays and offers the following services:-

- Day Care for older individuals and a specialist service in dementia care
- Day respite for carers, other services and activities to meet carers' needs
- Social care and activities for individuals who may be isolated
- Day care for those who have more physical needs
- Extended day care services to benefit individuals and their carers who require a longer day
- Fully staffed bathing service using specialised Parker Tilt bath
- Structured, personalised re-enablement service after illness or hospital stay (please enquire for details of this specialised service as it is tailored to meet individual needs)

**As an independent registered charity which has been in operation for over 60 years, the Lonsdale Trust Wallasey subsidises its services by using its charitable reserves and by fund raising.**

## Service Fees

Day Service Lonsdale Centre	-	9.00 am – 3.30 pm	-	£25.00
Day Service Granville Centre	-	9.00 am – 3.30 pm	-	£15.00

Both the Lonsdale and Granville Day Centres offer this service which includes a freshly prepared hot lunch, drinks and snacks throughout the session.

A wide range of day time activities are offered at both day centres for clients to participate in at will, as outlined in the sample day overleaf. Both day centres also have quiet areas in which clients can relax.

This service is currently available at the **Lonsdale Centre from Monday to Thursday** and includes the above together with a light meal at tea time. Limited spaces are available for this service and it is anticipated that this service may be offered in time at Granville Day Centre, if the demand arises.

The Trust offers a staffed **bathing service** at the Lonsdale Centre. This service is of particular use to those who have limited mobility or do not have suitable facilities in their home. It is available to all who need it, of any age or individual need, provided we can comply with our health and safety requirements. There is often a waiting list for this popular service so please contact us in good time so that you can be given details of availability and cost.

## Payment

Payment by Standing Order is the preferred method. When you commence services you will be given a schedule to the financial year end (March each year) with a breakdown of days attendance per month on a spreadsheet. This will show the amount required from your bank as a Standing Order payment each month.

As a non-profit making organisation we rely on our fee income to operate our services. We need to receive payment from our clients or their carers at the beginning of each month in advance. Payment for services is charged on a 'placement' basis: you are paying for your place, not for your attendance, as our expenditure remains the same once placements have been allocated and, as stated above, **our charity subsidises the service**. A week's notice is required on leaving our services and clients who leave will be given priority placement if they wish to return, although it must be noted that there is usually a waiting list for all our services.

Once you are with us at one of our day centres, all meals, drinks, snacks and activities are free of charge with the exception of our bathing service (see service fees above). Clients usually like to bring a **small amount** of spending money to take part in raffles and such.

Please inform us in good time of any absence so that our registers can be updated for the days you attend and bear in mind that you may need to inform other services of this (for example, relating to your transport or other care service arrangements). If you would like an extra day once you have settled, please let staff know in good time as we usually have a waiting list.

Please feel free to ask staff about any queries as they arise: it is our aim that you enjoy your time with us and to get the most out of our services.
